LUX BUH



THE GREEN COMFORT-MONSTER

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INFORMATION

Buh is crocheted from the top down. This means you will start with the head and continue into the body. The rounds will not be completed with a slip stitch as you will crochet in a spiral.

You can benefit from shifting the decreases and the increases, so that these will not be placed directly above each other in every round. This will give you a nicer result.

The finished Buh will be about 12-13 cm high if made with hook 2,5 mm.

MATERIALS

- 25 grams of green cotton yarn
- 5 grams of white cotton yarn
- 5 grams of black cotton yarn
- A little bit of red cotton yarn
- Pillow stuffing

The grams are with yarn that runs 160 meter in a skein of 50 grams.

For this yarn I use a 2.5 mm hook, so that the stuffing will not show.

Use the recommended hook for your yarn.

Keep in mind to have more yarn if the yarn you use is thicker.

ABBREVIATIONS

- 0 = Round
- (...) = Total number stitches when the round is complete
- [...] = Repeat x times
- Sc = Single crochet
- Ch = Chain
- Inc = Increase / 2 stitches in 1
- Dec = Decrease / 2 masker to 1

HEAD AND BODY

MADE IN GREEN COTTON YARN

01: Make a magic ring with 6 sc (6 sc)

02: [inc] x6 (12)

03: [inc, 1 sc] x6 (18)

04: [inc, 2 sc] x6 (24)

05: [inc, 3 sc] x6 (30)

06: [inc, 4 sc] x6 (36)

07: 1 sc in each stitch (36)

08: [inc, 5 sc] x6 (42)

09-13:1 sc in each stitch (42) - 5 rounds in total

014: [dec, 5 sc] x6 (36)

015: 1 sc in each stitch (36)

016: [dec, 4 sc] x6 (30)

017: 1 sc in each stitch (30)

018: [dec, 3 sc] x6 (24)

019-20: 1 sc in each stitch (24) – 2 rounds in total

021: [inc, 3 sc] x6 (30)

022: [inc, 4 sc] x6 (36)

023: [inc, 5 sc] x6 (42)

024: 1 sc in each stitch (42)

025: [inc, 6 sc] x6 (48)

026: 1 sc in each stitch (48)

027: [inc, 7 sc] x6 (54)

028: 1 sc in each stitch (54)

029: [inc, 8 sc] x6 (60)

030: 1 sc in each stitch (60)

031: [inc, 9 sc] x6 (66)

032-43: 1 sc in each stitch (66) – 12 rounds in total

Fill the head and neck with stuffing. Make sure to fill the neck tight so Buh will not drop his head. Fill the body as you go, so you will not have to fill it through a tiny hole.

044: [dec, 9 sc] x6 (60)

045: [dec, 8 sc] x6 (54)

046: [dec, 7 sc] x6 (48)

047: [dec, 6 sc] x6 (42)

048: [dec, 5 sc] x6 (36)

049: [dec, 4 sc] x6 (30)

050: [dec, 3 sc] x6 (24)

051: [dec, 2 sc] x6 (18)

052: [dec, 1 sc] x6 (12)

053: [dec] x6 (6)

Break the yarn and leave a thread. Sew the 6 sc hole close.



ARMS

MADE IN GREEN COTTON YARN

01: Make a magic ring with 6 sc (6)

02: [inc] x6 (12)

03-27: 1 sc in each stitch (12) – 25 rounds in total

028: Make 1 ch and press the arm flat. Crochet the arm close with 6 sc.

Make 2 arms in total.

Break the yarn and leave a thread for sewing the arm to the body.

The arm will be sewed on round 23. (see assemblement)



EYE

MADE IN BLACK COTTON YARN

01: Make a magic ring with 6 sc (6)

Break the yarn and leave a thread for sewing the pupil on to the white eye.

MADE IN WHITE COTTON YARN

01: Make a magic ring with 6 sc (6)

02: [Inc] x6 (12)

03: [Inc, 1 sc] x6 (18)

Break the yarn and leave a thread for sewing the eye to the head.

Sew on the black pupil in the middle of the white eye. Sew on the eye to the head.



ASSEMBLEMENT



1: Start by sewing the arms on to the body.

These are to be sewn on round 23 with about 10-12 sc between the arms seen from the back of Buh.



2: Sew on the pupil in the middle of the white eye.

Now sew on the eye to the head.

Embroider a mouth and a warm heart.

You can also embroider eyelashes.

Only your imagination will stop you from making your own personal Buh.
